The Liverpool City Region is becoming increasingly attractive to investors - just over the last year, the region saw an influx in VC funding and support initiatives.

According to Dealroom, since 2019 the city region has a seen a 657% increase in VC investment - comparatively, London only gained a 4% increase in the same time period – and our entrant data suggests that this will continue to rise with entrants declaring total funding that's a 110% increase on 2023 data.
