### **FUELLED FOR GROWTH**



84% of entrants are new to Tech Climbers 32.5% YoY increase



58% of entrants (under 1 year) have already received funding, contributing to the total of 9,915 start-ups\* that have secured funding across the UK.

The start-up economy in the UK consists of 4.4million companies out of which 266,789 start-up companies are in the Yorkshire area, growing at a rate of 8.6% per year contributing close to 64 billion in turnover. (The Data City, 2023)




### **FUNDING OUTLOOK**


71% of entrants are looking for funding to grow. Out of these...



60% are looking for combined Seed and Series A funding.



46% chose access to finance as the biggest barrier to growth



49% are looking for Seed funding.



70% of entrants host their own IP with 79% developing an IP strategy 71% of all applicants are looking for funding to grow, with 60% opting for Seed and Series A funding. Amongst our group of entrants 'access to finance' is the biggest barrier when thinking about the future of the business with 'access to talent' and 'marketing and sales strategy' being their joint second concern.
